
HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL WINE & SPIRITS FAIR

The doors are thrown open to the public on the third day of this massive industry event at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre, with masterclasses, seminars, and cocktail and whisky demonstrations galore, as well as more than 1,000 international exhibitors plying vinous and spirituous wares.

November 9-11

CLOCKENFLAP

Artistic polymath David Byrne heads the line-up at Hong Kong's largest music and arts event, Clockenflap, in which 30,000 people descend on the Central Harbourfront event space on each of the festival's three days to take in dozens of acts. The former Talking Heads frontman is joined as headliner by indie outfit Interpol.



November 16-18

TRAILWALKER

More than 5,000 runners and walkers in teams of four take part in Hong Kong's biggest trail race, Oxfam Trailwalker, to raise money for charity. The tough 100-kilometre route takes runners from the beaches of Sai Kung over mountainous terrain to the hills of Tuen Mun. Top teams are likely to include Team Nepal and the People's Liberation Army, but can they break the 2013 course record of 10 hours 58 minutes set by the all-Nepalese Team Columbia?

ASIA-PACIFIC

November 8-25

TAIPEI GOLDEN HORSE FILM FESTIVAL

The largest film festival in Taiwan returns for its 55th year, with the awards ceremony held on November 17. Paying homage to Swedish director Ingmar Bergman, the festival collaborates with the Taichung Film Development Foundation to present 38 screenings of his films.

November 12-17

DUBAI DESIGN WEEK

With roughly 230 events, including exhibitions, installations and workshops from more than 100 companies, this is the Middle East's largest creative festival, which is into its fourth year. Held in the Dubai Design District and throughout the city, the festival's highlights include the Global Green Week Show, which showcases innovations from graduates worldwide.



November 23-24

ROMEO & JULIET

The contemporary dance performance by the acclaimed Russian State Ballet of Siberia premieres at the Sands Theatre at Marina Bay Sands under the artistic direction and choreography of a former Bolshoi Theatre Ballet principal dancer, Sergei Bobrov, accompanied by Sergei Prokofiev's memorable ballet score.

EUROPE & AMERICAS

Until November 4

SALON DU CHOCOLAT 2018

The world's largest event dedicated to chocolate and cocoa is in its 24th year. Held at Porte de Versailles, Paris, it has more than 230 exhibitors, including master chocolate and pastry makers, presenting a diverse spread of chocolates from around the world. This year, the Salon focuses on cocoa, exploring its origins and cultivation.

November 1-14

GRAND PRIX D'HORLOGERIE DE GENÈVE

The prestigious horology awards present 72 watches pre-selected by 31 international jury members. On display at the Musée d'Art et d'Histoire in Geneva, Switzerland, the watches compete for one of 16 awards, including two new ones – the Challenge Watch Prize and the Audacity Prize.



November 22-December 7

MONTREAL BACH FESTIVAL

Honouring the musical legacy of Johann Sebastian Bach, the festival is returning for its 12th year. A selection of the composer's instrumental and vocal works is performed by world-class talents such as Julian Prégardien, Mélisande McNabney and Yo-Yo Ma.
